2. Tenderers/bidders are requested to visit the website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> regularly. Any changes/modifications in tender enquiry will be intimated by corrigendum through this website only.
3. In case, any holiday is declared by the Government on the day of opening, the tenders will be opened on the next working day at the same time. The Council reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders.
4. The interested Firms are required to deposit (in original) an **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)** amount in the form of Demand Draft from any of the Nationalized Bank in favour of "**BESST-HORT**" payable at **Bangalore may be address to CEO, BESST-HORT, ICAR-IIHR, Hessaraghatta Lake Post, Bangalore-560089** on or before **bid opening date and time as mentioned in the Critical Date Sheet**.

Terms & Conditions

1. The tenderer shall quote rates, which will include the packaging, delivery & other incidental charges. Taxes, if any, should be indicated separately.
2. The rates should be quoted as per the BOQ uploaded on the CPP Portal (reference may be obtained from Annexure-III). Taxes, if any, should be indicated separately. It must be noted that the contract shall be awarded to the firm which fulfils all the required terms and conditions and remains L-I for any particular items.
3. The firm must also possess valid PAN No. & GST registration number and a copy of the same must also be enclosed with the tender document.
4. Copy of previous three years of Income Tax Return may be furnished.
5. The firm should be in existence for over 05 (Five) years in the trade with the business turnover of not less than Rs.50 lakh per annum during the last three years. Documents to this effect may be enclosed.
6. Modification in the tender documents after the closing date is not permissible.
7. The successful firm shall have to supply the various Scientific Equipment's within 6 weeks from the date of confirmed supply order. If the materials are not supplied in time then the order shall be cancelled and EMD shall be forfeited. The rates quoted should be valid for 180 days from the date of opening of tender.
8. The contractor/bidder or his representative may contact the undersigned at **Tel. No.7760883948** for any further clarification. No variation in terms of quality of the items shall be entertained.
9. The President, BESST-HORT, ICAR-IIHR, shall have the right to reject all or any of the offers, accept more than one offer, and assign part of the job without assigning any reason.
10. Merely quoting of lowest rates does not mean that order shall be given to that firm. The competent authority will finally decide on the basis of quality & performance of past installations.
11. The interested Firms are required to deposit (in original) an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the form of Demand Draft in favour of **"BEEST-HORT" payable at Bangalore** and may be addressed to **CEO, BESST-HORT, TBI of ICAR-IIHR, Hessaraghatta Lake Post, Bangalore-560089 on or before bid opening date and time as mentioned in the Critical Date Sheet.** No bid shall be considered without the earnest money deposit. Demand draft drawn in favour of any officer other than **'BESST-HORT,** " payable at Bangalore will not be accepted and the tender will be rejected. 12. Rates once finalized will not be enhanced/reduced during the currency of the contract.
13. In case of foreign currency, conversion rates in INR will be taken on that day when financial bid will open.
14. In case, the successful bidder shows inability at any stage, after the contract is finalized and awarded, for whatsoever reason(s), the earnest money /performance security deposited would be forfeited.
15. The President, BESST-HORT, ICAR- IIHR reserves the right to cancel the contract at any time during the currency period of the contract without giving any reason.
16. The firm to whom the tender will be awarded, will have to deposit the performance security equal to 10% of the total amount at the time of installation of the equipment. If the services are not found to be satisfactory, the performance security is liable to be forfeited. No interest will be paid on performance security.
17. If any dispute(s) arises between BESST-HORT, ICAR-IIHR and the firm with reference to the contract, BESST-HORT, ICAR-IIHR will decide it and its decision will be binding on the firms.

19. The contract will be given to item-wise least one (L1).
20. Payment:-
- a) Payment for goods supplied from abroad
 - i) On shipment 90% of the contract price (CIP) shall be paid through irrevocable letter of credit upon submission of documents detailed in L/C.
 - ii) 10% of the contract price (CIP) (in foreign currency), Bangalore Airport, will be released after satisfactory installation/working of equipment/machine etc. as well as on submission/production of Performance Bank Guarantee by the Supplier(s).
 - iii) 100% payment through online transfer/FDD after satisfactory installation and submission of Performance Bank Guarantee by the supplier.
 - b) Payment of goods supplied within India
 - j) 100% of the contract price on receipt of goods by the consignee supported by satisfactory installation/working report & submission of Performance Bank Guarantee.
22. Installation: - Within **15 days from the date of receipt of equipment** in the Institute failing which Liquidated Damage clause shall apply.
- Liquidated Damage clause: It would be realized @ 0.5% (half per cent) of the base price (excluding taxes) of the delayed goods for each week of delay subject to maximum 20%.
23. Prices:
- i. Price to be quoted in INR and to be delivered @ ICAR-IIHR Hesaraghatta, Bangalore.
 - ii. In case the stores pertain to Import:
 - a) Kindly ensure to enclose manufacturer's authorization in favour of Indian subsidiary firm / Supplier. It may also be noted that further authorization by subsidiary firm in favour of any other firm located in India to promote their sale must have authorization from the Principal firm for further authorization to an Indian firm, failing which the tender is liable to be cancelled.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

REGISTRATION

- Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.) by clicking on the link '**Online bidder Enrollment**' on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (class II or Class III certificates with signing key usage) issued by any certifying authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify/nCode/eMudhra etc.) with their profile.
- Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
- Bidder then log in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their users ID/password and the password of the DSC/e-Token.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- There are various search options built in the CPP Portal. To facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents/tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS/e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification/help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

- Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in

which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents- including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.

- Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document/schedule and generally, they can be in PDF/XLS/RAR/DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use 'My Space' or 'Other important Documents' area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the 'My Space' area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- Bidder has to select the payment option as 'offline' to pay the EMD as applicable and enter details of the instrument (DD number, amount, date, bank etc.)
- Bidder should prepare the EMD as per the instructions specified in the tender document. The original should be posted/couriered/given in person to the concerned official, latest by the last date of bid submission or as specified in the tender documents. The details of the DD/any other accepted instrument, physically sent, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time. Otherwise the uploaded bid will be rejected.
- Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the Format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BoQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BoQ file, open it and complete the white coloured (unprotected) cell with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BoQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.
- The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.

- All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128-bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric, encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid openers public keys.
- Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (i.e. after clicking 'Freeze Bid Submission' in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message and a bid summary will be displayed with the bid number and the date and time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
- The bid summary has to printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.
